


NOTES FROM THE DIRECTOR

DIRECTOR

Luis Muñoz Cubillo, also known as Soto, was born in 2000 in Baena (Córdoba).

In 2021, he premiered his first audiovisual piece **"Tale of a Lemon Tree"** at the International Medium-Length Film Festival of Valencia, receiving mentions for best script and best medium-length film by the senior jury.

"Dreams and Crumbs" hist first feature film, was premiered at Atlàntida Mallorca Film Fest (Mallorca, Spain) and won the Agustí Villaronga Award for Best National Film in Spain. It was also selected at Ibertigo, Ibero American Cinema Showcase of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, at the Rizoma Official Selection International Festival of Intertwined Culture (Madrid, Spain), at SEFF Seville European Film Festival (Seville, Spain), at Ibizacinefest (Ibiza, Spain), at D'A Festival de Barcelona (Barcelona, Spain) and at San Sebastian Film Festival (San Sebastian, Spain).

In 2023 he made his second feature film "The Trail Left By Time" co-directed with Alfredo Picazo which was selected at the Marché du Film of Cannes Docs and was premiered at 61 FICX Gijon International Film Festival where it won the FIPRESCI Award for best film, the AMAE Award for best spanish film editing for Rafael Cano and the special mention for best spanish Film. Additionally, it participated in Documenta Madrid (2024) where it received a Special Mention from the jury. He also won at Seville European Film Festival the Juan Antonio Bermúdez award for best Andalusian Film.

Currently, he is developing his next feature film titled "Don Quixote according to Juan Trujillo" selected at **Cinema Pendent, and Extremlab of L'Alternativa Film Festival.**

His works are characterized by the use of rural areas as a setting. Interested in decentralized production models, he shoots his films immersing them in an escapist aura in contrast to urban freneticism. His films deal with themes such as absence, memory, or adolescent drift, impregnated with traces of magical realism and phantasmagoria inherited from Ibero-American literature.



MUBOX STUDIO

PRODUCTION & DISTRIBUTION COMPANY

In 2021, Mubox Studio was established as an independent production and distribution company to promote and support new talents.

They began by producing and distributing short films such as "**The Tale of the Lemon Tree**" by Luis (Soto) Muñoz, "**When The Pure Forms Sank**" by Alfredo Picazo, and "**Smells**" by Alba Esquinas.

In 2023, they ventured into feature film production with "**Dreams and Crumbs**" by Luis (Soto) Muñoz, which won the Best National Film award at the Atlántida Mallorca Film Fest and was selected for Ibértigo, Rizoma, the Seville Festival, Ibizacinefest, and the D'A Barcelona Festival (Open ECAM Award), San Sebastian International Film Festival, Córdoba Cinema Week (Best Movie Award).

Their second feature film, **"The Trail Left by Time"** by Luis (Soto) Muñoz and Alfredo Picazo, was selected for Cannes Docs at the Marché du Film and premiered at the 61st edition of the Gijón International Film Festival, where it won three awards, including the FIPRESCI for Best Film in the official section Tierres en Trance. It was also selected for the Las Palmas de Gran Canaria International Film Festival, Documenta Madrid, where it received a special mention from the jury and 21 Sevilla European Film Festival (Best Film Andalusian Panorama)

In 2024, they have in post-production the documentary short film "**The Widowers**" by Alba Esquinas and in 2025 the feature film "**Who Witnessed the Temples Fall**" by Lucía Alonso will be premiered.

Among the projects in development by the production company are the feature films: "BAI BAI" directed by Alba Esquinas, "Nuestra Piel Levantada" by Paolo Natale, and "Don Quixote according to Juan Trujillo" directed by Luis (Soto) Muñoz.

Additionally, they continue to distribute short films and develop new projects with the aim of consolidating their production company in the national scene.
