




#### **SYNOPSIS**





#### **DIRECTOR'S NOTES**

At that time, it had been three years since I had last seen my father. During that period, he went through a drug dependency that required a long rehabilitation process. This project was meant to be our reunion; the plan was to film his move into his new house, capturing all his furniture and belongings that had been stored away in a warehouse for the past few years. It was March 2020, and we all know what happened then. During those months, every day (without receiving any specific direction), my father would send me a video recorded on his phone. Throughout my father's recordings, lacking the confidence to directly ask me about my life, most of what we talked about was cinema or books. In a way, each recommendation I made was a strategy for him to imagine the movie I wanted to create and to change the way he filmed. I believe cinema is expressive from the moment a specific creative process is chosen. Using creation to heal wounds and move forward has been the guiding principle of this process.








#### **ABOUT THE DIRECTOR**

In 2021, Mubox Studio was established as an independent production and distribution company to promote and support new talents.
